Forever. -- That's ETERNITY!

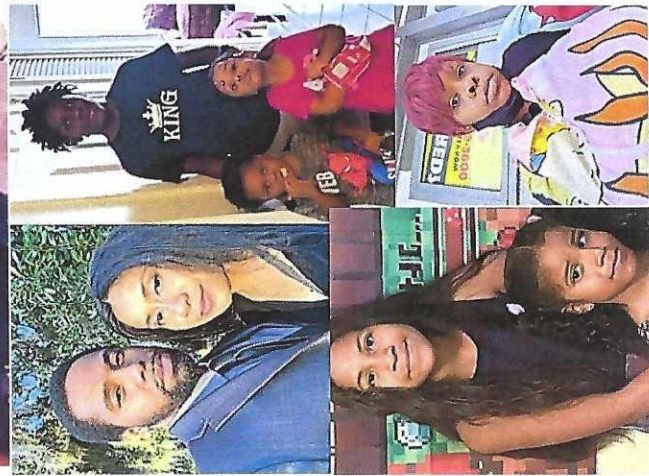


Thy limb has fallen from the family tree that says:
